The following year Paramount Pictures released a feature film celebrating those teenagers and popularizing the fast growing disco revolution with its symphony orchestrated music and its elaborate and exciting choreography. The movie, SATURDAY NIGHT FEVER, was a sensation! Pretty soon disco became the dominant music of the late 70's and early 80's. Everyone was listening and dancing to it.


(I'll bet some of you even have a white suit or a disco dress stuffed in the back of your closet.)

Of course it was inevitable that this wildly popular film would find its way to the stage. The 1998 London premier was followed by a Broadway opening in 2000. The musical ran for over 500 performances on Broadway and then toured and played in regional theatres across the nation.

Now, starting on New Year's Eve, this terrific show will find a home on the Fireside stage and I'm really excited about bringing it to you.

The show has all the great music from the Bee Gees like "Staying Alive," "You Should be Dancing," "Fever," and "How Deep is Your Love," It also will feature spectacular dancing and the moving, romantic story of Tony Manero, a Brooklyn teen who seeks to escape his dreary life amid the pulse and beat of disco. It'll all be there - the sights, the sounds, the moves, the costumes, and of course the mirror ball!

## HOSPITALITY NEVER GOES OUT OF STYLE!


The Broadway mega-musical SATURDAY NIGHT FEVER, based on the popular 1977 film, has been referred to as a "one-of-a-kind miracle in song, dance, and simplicity." For some, the classic film came to define the 1970's. Now the stage version's own unique blend of poignancy and perpetual optimism - coupled with the brilliance of the Bee Gees score and breathtaking choreography - is bound to dazzle and delight you!

The movie was based on a New York Magazine article which described the lives of working-class Italian-Americans in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn in 1976, who lived for their nights when they danced at the local disco, 2001 Odyssey. At the heart of this lavish musical lies a very simple story about basic human longings – about a guy wanting to go out with the girl of his dreams and live up to his own simple dreams for himself. People want to get out and do something more with their lives, it's a story that goes on year after year in villages, small towns, and big cities everywhere in the world.

## LEARNING FROM EACH OTHER

You know how there are certain things you always like to do when you're entertaining guests from out of town? Like take them to your favorite restaurant for dinner or take in the gorgeous scenery at your nearest State Park? Here in Fort Atkinson there are several things we locals like to share with our guests and we want to make sure you know about them, too. Since the #1 attraction to share in Fort Atkinson is The Fireside, here are a few more things you can consider adding to your Fireside trips, or even use to add a whole extra day in Fort Atkinson.

Just up the road along Janesville Avenue you'll find the NASCO Catalog Outlet Store. Fort Atkinson was the original headquarters for the National Agricultural and Science Company and is a treasure trove of unique educational and agricultural items. Besides what you'll find in the store, whatever you see in their catalog can be plucked from the adjoining warehouse. That includes everything from early childhood education and professional artist supplies to farm and ranch grooming products.

One block further to the north lies another unexpected "treasure trove" but this one includes bacon! The Jones Market is a retail outlet for the delicious Jones products the company has been making here since the 1830's. You'll find some of the products we use on our Sunday Brunch such as their Cherrywood Smoked Bacon, Hickory Smoked Ham, Maple Sausage Links, Canadian Bacon,



and a whole lot more. The size of the market was tripled a few years ago making them better able to serve tour groups. Three coaches at a time is about their limit, though, so be sure to call ahead to let them know you're stopping by. That way they'll have enough samples ready (yum!) and staff to serve you. Then your coach driver can swing by before the show gets out to pick up your group's packages.

In the spirit of Fort Atkinson's "Love Where You Live" campaign, we invite you to explore our favorite places.

Our final suggestion today is another treasure trove - this one of historical artifacts from the area's local history and Wisconsin's dairy history. The Hoard Historical Museum and National Dairy Shrine can be found at 401 Whitewater Avenue. Centered around the Victorian era home of former Wisconsin governor W.D. Hoard (also known as the father of American dairying), you can enjoy self-guided tours of the Hoard House, Mysteries of the Mounds exhibit, the Lincoln Era Library, and the National Dairy Shrine Museum. The museum staff recommends allowing at least an hour and making a reservation in advance. Although there is no formal charge to visit them, donations are gratefully accepted. In addition to their permanent exhibits, temporary additions include local art shows, displays recognizing prominent area residents, and special traveling exhibits. For more on these ideas or others, just ask your group sales representative.






# THE FIRESIDE'S 2020 SEASON OF FAVORITES!


