I have loved the adventures of Miss Marple and especially Hercule Poirot – one of the greatest detectives in all of fiction. I have to say as an admittedly know-it-all mystery fan, while I love Christie's writing and am always entertained by her work, I sometimes have found her books to be a bit predictable. I can usually figure out who the murderer is halfway through the book.

That is of course until I read MURDER ON THE ORIENT EXPRESS. That book blew me away. I never saw the ending coming. No wonder it is her most popular story.

There have been a number of film versions of the book but only one play that I know of – the one we are

presenting in April. The stage version of MURDER ON THE ORIENT EXPRESS was written by Ken Ludwig – a Tony winning playwright of such comedy hits as LEND ME A TENOR and MOON OVER BUFFALO. His version of Christie's great masterpiece is engaging, fast moving, and will keep you guessing right up to that fabulous ending. (No spoilers here)

We don't do plays very often. They have to be first rate entertainments to make it to the Fireside stage. Such a play is MURDER ON THE ORIENT EXPRESS. Take the word of a life-long mystery nerd. It is a not to be missed theatrical adventure.

This show we will be featuring several dishes that are new to The Fireside. First, Mahi-Mahi, a Subtropical fish native to the gulf of Mexico and the Pacific Ocean. It's a very lean white meat fish known for its firm flakey meat and it's sweet flavor. We'll grill the Mahi-Mahi to impart a nice char and smokiness to the fish. The sauce will be a puree of fresh orange juice, mango, honey, and Jalapeno pepper. The floral notes of the honey and Mango will pair perfectly with the grilled Mahi-Mahi.

Secondly, a new rendition of our braised beef short ribs. We'll sear the short ribs to lock in the juices and slowly braise them in a blend of San Marzano tomatoes, kalamata olives, capers, basil and Red wine. After the Beef has cooked until meltingly tender, the braising liquid will be reduced and served over the short rib. This dish is packed with amazing and complex flavors and the sauce is incredible. You'll want extra bread to soak up every bit of it.

Our featured vegetarian entree will be a pasta prima vera. Prima Vera means "Prime Vegetables" or simply what's fresh and available. We'll take zucchinni, Italian squash, fresh tomatoes, bell peppers, and mushrooms and sauté them until fragrant. We deglaze the vegetables in white wine and add garlic chili flakes and butter to make a delicious and light sauce. The vegetables will be tossed and

served with pappardelle pasta, a long and thin ribbon-like pasta, and topped with parmesan cheese and fresh torn basil. So many great choices - let us know what you think!


